DL Moody famously said, "If I could relive my life, I would devote my entire ministry reaching children for God."

There is nothing better than to watch a child grasp what lesus did for them. When a kid learns a verse or finds a book of the Bible all by themselves and cries out, "I got it!", it's priceless. Children's Ministry can be crazy and loud. It can be frustrating and fun, but it very rarely feels fruitless. We seek to make learning about the Lord exciting and try to provide a loving atmosphere to demonstrate the Lord's love for them.

Miss Ruth, Miss Lori and all their amazing adult and teen helpers work together to teach the Word of God. Ruth and the Sunday School teachers are with the kids from 10 to 11 a.m. every Sunday. The children meet together to sing, enjoy an object lesson or puppet skit. They then divide into appropriate age groups for a bible lesson and learning.
